The weekend begins on Thursday evening, July 26th with check in at 5:30pm at OLG and ends Sunday, July 29, 2018 with Mass at OLG at 4:30pm. Transportation to and from the retreat center, meals and lodging at the retreat center are included in the cost of the retreat.

Holy Scripture and the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church are the guides for the retreat.

Before you fill out information, please note how the registration process works. This is **NOT** done on a first-come, first-serve basis. Instead, we accept registration forms until, July 6th and eligible retreatants will be picked at random via a lottery system to give everyone a fair chance to attend. The names will be picked by July 11th. Those teens picked will be contacted and the fees can then be paid. If the fees are not paid by the due date of July 16th, the teen will forfeit his or her spot to the next teen on the waiting list. Preference is given to 1st time OLG parishioners, followed by non-OLG parishioners, and then teens that have been on a prior Teen ACTS retreat.

“They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to prayer. Awe came upon everyone and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. All who believed were together and had all things in common: they would sell their property and possessions and divide them among all according to each one’s need. Every day they devoted themselves to meeting together in the temple area and to breaking bread in their homes. They ate their meals in exultation and sincerity of heart, praising God and enjoying favor with all the people. And every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.”
